

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

ACTION ITEM: Arizona State University requests authorization to approve a new award from the Kellogg W.K. Foundation #P0111416

ISSUE: The Board is requested to approve acceptance of a new award to Arizona State University from the Kellogg W.K. Foundation.

BACKGROUND:

- ASU has received a new award from the Kellogg W.K. Foundation for support of the School of Community Resources and Development, College of Public Programs project. The obligated amount of the award is \$2,200,000.00 federal funding. No matching or cost share is required.
- The objective of the project is for the AIM (Arizona Indiana Michigan) Alliance to utilize knowledge sharing and strengthening communities of color; cross-delivery of flagship programs; development of standardized research protocols and joint publication and dissemination of research; and cross-participation in significant events.
- ASU project director is Robert F. Ashcroft, School of Community Resources and Development.
- The project period is January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2009.

The Board of Regents authorizes ASU to finalize this agreement for this project for the School of Community Resources and Development.
