UA STUDENT SELECTED AS NEW REGENT
Wildcat to Serve Two Years on Board of Regents

PHOENIX – Governor Janet Napolitano has appointed University of Arizona student David Martinez III to the Arizona Board of Regents as the Student Regent. Martinez is a Secondary Education senior from Marana, Arizona. He will serve on the Board for two years; he becomes a voting member during his second year of service.

“David is very innovation-oriented and expressed a desire to bring new, fresh ideas to Arizona’s university system,” Governor Napolitano said. “He is focused on moving forward the university system, making it more available to Arizona students, and in creating a learning environment that will graduate a workforce prepared for the global market.”

Martinez has worked as an intern for Congressman Raúl Grijalva and as a student correspondent for Tucson’s Arizona Daily Star. He currently works in the Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Office at the University of Arizona and serves as the Election Commissioner for the Associated Students of the University of Arizona. He was the recipient of the University of Arizona Minority Student Achievement Award.
