### **Arizona Board of Regents Member, Jack B. Jewett, appointed to National Higher Education Association**

The Association of Governing Boards of Universities and Colleges (AGB) named Jack B. Jewett to its Board of Directors at its November 2004 Board meeting. Jewett, a member of the Arizona Board of Regents, is Senior Vice President of Public Policy for Tucson Medical Center, Tucson, Arizona. He was appointed to the Arizona Board of Regents in 1998 and served as Board president from July 2002 to June 2003.

“Jack is extremely deserving of this prestigious national appointment,” said Arizona Board of Regents President Gary Stuart. “He has made tremendous contributions to Arizona’s university system, and the Association of Governing Boards of Universities

and Colleges is indeed fortunate to have an individual of his caliber serving on its Board.”

In March 2004, Jewett was awarded the Distinguished Service Award in Trusteeship, a national honor from AGB, for his leadership in changing the strategic direction of the Arizona University System.
